

Q How old do the kittens need to be before they can be fixed?

A Kittens should be 10 weeks old, no longer nursing, at least 2 pounds and healthy.

Q What if I don't have a computer or an email address?

A If you don't have a computer or an email address, a friend or family member can assist by submitting the application for you. They will have to confirm the application receipt and provide you with any necessary information.

Q Can I mail or fax in my application?

A At this time, SNAP is only able to accept on-line applications.

Q How old do I have to be to submit an application?

A You must be 18 years and the legal owner of the cat(s).

Trap Neuter Return (TNR)

No cost spay/neuter for stray neighbourhood cats.

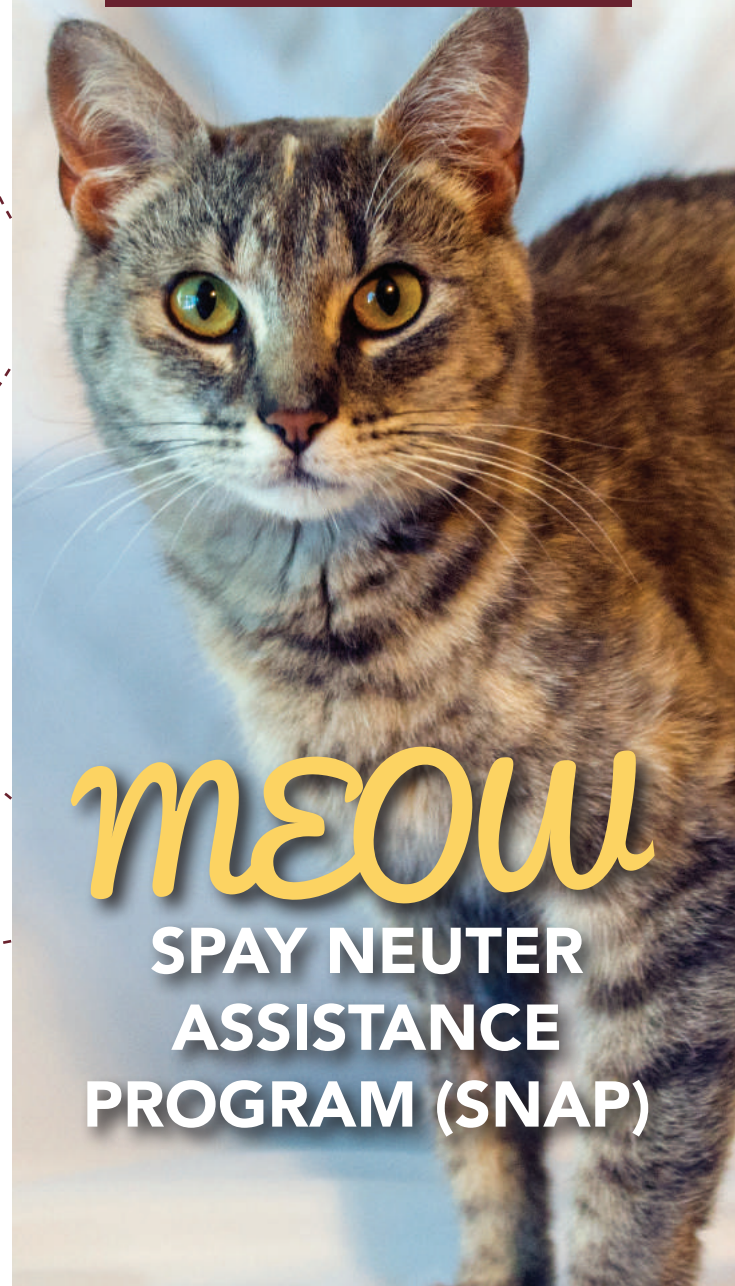

About SNAP

MEOW Foundation's Spay Neuter Assistance Program subsidizes the cost of feline spay and neuter surgeries for Calgarians financially in-need and promotes responsible pet ownership.

Q How much does it cost?

A Approved applicants pay a portion of the cost and SNAP pays the remainder of the fee to the vet clinic.

Q How many cats can I have fixed?

A There is no limit. All your cats qualify.

Q I have a litter of kittens to fix. Is there a discount for a whole litter?

A Yes. SNAP can provide an economical rate based on the information in your application.

Q How do I pay?

A The person who drops the cat(s) off at the vet clinic the morning of the surgery must have the payment with them. Clinics accept VISA, Master Card, Debit or Cash. Personal cheques are not accepted.

Q What does the fee cover?

A The fee covers the initial examination, the spay or neuter surgery, and a mandatory microchip, or tattoo for identification.

Q Do I have to prove my income?

A Generally no, but it may be requested in some circumstances.

Q Does my cat have to be vaccinated first?

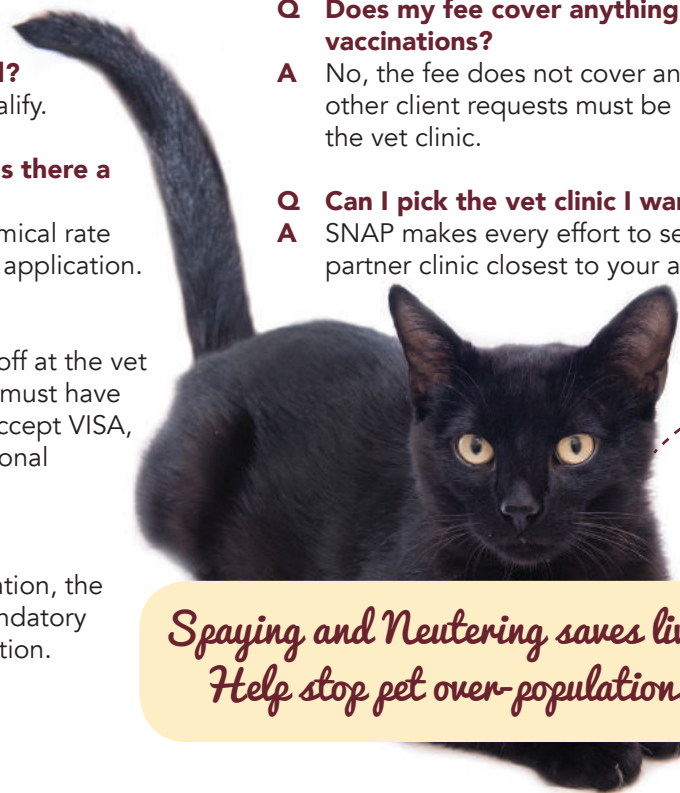
A No. Cats with no vaccinations are accepted by SNAP.

Q Does my fee cover anything else such as vaccinations?

A No, the fee does not cover any extras. Any other client requests must be paid directly to the vet clinic.

Q Can I pick the vet clinic I want to go to?

A SNAP makes every effort to send you to a partner clinic closest to your address.

Q Do you make the appointment for me?

A No, you will book the appointment once you receive your clinic information from SNAP.

Q Does Snap provide transportation to the clinic?

A No, SNAP is unable to offer transportation. You must transport your cat to and from the clinic on the appointment day.

Q I can't make my appointment. What do I do?

A You must give the vet clinic a minimum of 24 hours notice to cancel or re-schedule, or your authorization may be cancelled.

Q How long do I have to get my cat(s) spayed or neutered?

A The authorization period is for 30 days.

Q What if I need more than the 30 day authorization period?

A Email the SNAP Administrator and request an extension. If you are having several cats spayed or neutered, we recommend having the females spayed first.

Q My cat had kittens. When can I have the mother cat fixed?

A Mother cats can be fixed once the kittens are fully weaned.

Q My cat might be pregnant. Can she be spayed?

A Apply to SNAP and then discuss this with your assigned veterinary clinic staff.
