



Temporary Care for Your Cat

1. Calgary Humane Society offers a Pet Safe Keeping and Emergency Boarding program
 - **Pet Safe Keeping** is for victims of domestic violence and offers short term housing at no charge for individuals in crisis due to family violence or abuse
 - **Emergency Boarding** is for people with pets who are in crisis due to situations such as emergency hospitalization, loss of a house due to a fire or natural disasters such as floodingFor more details:

2. If you are a senior age 65 and over with limited mobility and social support and live in Calgary and are in need of assistance with pet care, contact the Seniors Resource Society: 403-266-6200 or info@calgaryseniors.org
3. Consider using a boarding kennel or an in-home cat sitter
4. For all other temporary care need situations, you can try creating a poster that includes:
 - Your contact information
 - Pet details including the age, temperament, medications and diet details
 - Length of term for care
 - Offer to cover medical costs, food, litter and other supplies
5. To advertise your poster for temporary care:
 - Reach out to relatives, friends, neighbours and colleagues
 - Advertise online at no charge on kijiji, The Calgary Herald and The Calgary Sun
 - Put your poster up at several locations in your neighbourhood, including community centres, veterinarians, convenience and grocery stores
 - Deliver your poster door to door in your neighbourhood, apartment building or condo complex
