



Veterinary Financial Assistance for Your Cat

We empathize with your situation. Many animal guardians face difficult decisions when pets require serious medical care. Due to limited resources, MEOW is not able to offer financial assistance. Below are some possible options for consideration.

1. MEOW Foundation's SNAP program assists only with the cost of spay or neuter surgery
2. Consider asking friends or family for assistance
3. Inquire at your veterinary clinic or other clinics about a possible payment plan
4. If you are low income, disabled or a senior residing in Alberta, speak to your veterinary clinic about eligibility through [Tails of Help](#)
5. [Parachutes for Pets](#) subsidizes veterinary care for low income seniors, disabled individuals receiving CPP disability, persons receiving assistance through Alberta Works Program and homeless individuals with pets.

7. Some VCA clinics offer financing support through [PayBright](#)

Unexpected veterinary costs can be challenging for many pet owners. MEOW recommends pet insurance or creating a savings account for your pet in case of emergencies.
