Established in 2000, MEOW Foundation is a cat specific registered not for profit organization with a no kill mandate. Our Rescue and Adoption Program provides food, shelter, and medical care to stray and abandoned cats in Calgary and facilitates their adoption into new, loving, permanent homes. MEOW also offers a subsidized Spay/Neuter Assistance (SNAP) program for Calgarian's in need and Trap, Neuter and Return (TNR) program for feral cats. Through our programs we advocate for responsible, compassionate animal care and assist over 2500 cats each year. In November 2019 Meow Foundation successfully opened a Thrift Store which is wholly owned and operated by the foundation.
